

Lone Star Governance Board's Student Outcome Goals for the Superintendent -Goal Progress Measures

Student Outcome Goal 1

The percent of students in grades K-3 reading on or above grade level will increase from 54 percent to 64 percent by June 2022. (Baseline measure May 2017)

Annual targets:

- School year 17–18 = 56 percent
- School year 18–19 = 58 percent
- School year 19–20 = 60 percent
- School year 20–21 = 62 percent
- School year 21–22 = 64 percent

Goal Progress Measure 1.1:

The percent of students in grades K and 1 reading on or above grade level will increase from 55 percent to 64 percent by June 2022. (Baseline measure May 2017)

Annual targets:

- School year 17–18 = 55 percent
- School year 18–19 = 57 percent
- School year 19–20 = 59 percent
- School year 20–21 = 62 percent
- School year 21–22 = 64 percent

Goal Progress Measure 1.2:

The percent of students in grade 2 reading on or above grade level will increase from 58 percent to 64 percent by June 2022. (Baseline measure May 2017)

Annual targets:

- School year 17–18 = 59 percent
- School year 18–19 = 60 percent
- School year 19–20 = 61 percent
- School year 20–21 = 62 percent
- School year 21–22 = 64 percent

Goal Progress Measure 1.3:

The percent of students in grade 3 reading on or above grade level will increase from 51 percent to 64 percent by June 2022. (Baseline measure May 2017)

Annual targets:

- School year 17–18 = 53 percent
- School year 18–19 = 55 percent
- School year 19–20 = 58 percent
- School year 20–21 = 61 percent
- School year 21–22 = 64 percent

Student Outcome Goal 2

The percent of students in grades 3 – Algebra 1 meeting standard on STAAR mathematics will increase from 66 percent to 76 percent by June 2023. (Baseline measure 2017-8 STAAR Mathematics)

Annual targets:

- School year 18–19 = 68 percent
- School year 19–20 = 70 percent
- School year 20–21 = 72 percent
- School year 21–22 = 74 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 76 percent

Goal Progress Measure 2.1:

The percent of students in grade 3 meeting standard on STAAR mathematics will increase from 63 percent to 77 percent by June 2023. (Baseline measure 2018 STAAR Mathematics)

Annual Targets:

- School year 18–19 = 66 percent
- School year 19–20 = 69 percent
- School year 20–21 = 72 percent
- School year 21–22 = 75 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 77 percent

Goal Progress Measure 2.2:

The percent of students in grade 5 meeting standard on STAAR mathematics will increase from 77 percent to 84 percent by June 2023. (Baseline measure 2018 STAAR Mathematics)

Annual Targets:

- School year 18–19 = 79 percent
- School year 19–20 = 81 percent
- School year 20–21 = 82 percent
- School year 21–22 = 83 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 84 percent

Goal Progress Measure 2.3:

The percent of students in Algebra 1 meeting standard on STAAR Algebra 1 End-of-Course will increase from 73 percent to 83 percent by June 2023 (baseline measure 2018 STAAR Mathematics).

Annual Targets:

- School year 18–19 = 75 percent
- School year 19–20 = 77 percent
- School year 20–21 = 79 percent
- School year 21–22 = 81 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 83 percent

Student Outcome Goal 3:

The College, Career, and Military Readiness scaled score will increase from 61 to 82 by June 2023 (baseline measure class of 2017 reported in 2018).

Annual targets:

- School year 18–19 = 65
- School year 19–20 = 69
- School year 20–21 = 73
- School year 21–22 = 77
- School Year 22–23 = 82

Goal Progress Measure 3.1:

The percent of students meeting Texas Success Initiative (TSI) criteria in both ELA/reading and mathematics on any of the assessments (Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA), SAT, ACT, College Prep Course) will increase from 16 percent to 25 percent by June 2023 (Baseline measure of 2017 reported in 2018)

Annual targets:

- School year 18–19 = 18 percent
- School year 19–20 = 20 percent
- School year 20–21 = 22 percent
- School year 21–22 = 24 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 25 percent

Goal Progress Measure 3.2:

The percent of students meeting the criterion score on an AP or IB examination in any subject area (criterion score is 3 or more for AP and 4 or more for IB) will increase from 8 percent to 18 percent by June 2023 (Baseline Class of 2017 reported in 2018).

Annual targets:

- School year 18–19 = 10 percent
- School year 19–20 = 12 percent
- School year 20–21 = 14 percent

- School year 21–22 = 16 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 18 percent

Goal Progress Measure 3.3:

The percent of students completing and earning credit for at least three credit hours in English language arts (ELA) or mathematics or at least nine credit hours in any subject will increase from 13 percent to 25 percent by June 2023 (Baseline Class of 2017 reported in 2018).

Annual targets:

- School year 18–19 = 17 percent
- School year 19–20 = 19 percent
- School year 20–21 = 21 percent
- School year 21–22 = 23 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 25 percent

Goal Progress Measure 3.4:

The percent of graduates earning an industry-based certificate under 19 TAC, 74.1003 to increase from 1 percent to 10 percent by June 2023 (Baseline Class of 2017 reported in 2018).

Annual targets:

- School year 18–19 = 3 percent
- School year 19–20 = 5 percent
- School year 20–21 = 7 percent
- School year 21–22 = 9 percent
- School Year 22–23 = 10 percent
