**GED Test Information**    Tests are offered in English and Spanish

Four content areas:

- Reasoning Through Language Arts (155 minutes)
- Mathematical Reasoning (120 minutes)
- Science (95 minutes)
- Social Studies (75 minutes)

Note: Time may include a tutorial and scheduled break.

**Cost:** Each test costs \$36.25                      **Total:** \$145.00

Candidates are required to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled start test time to allow for the Admissions process which includes, but is not limited, to the following:

- Candidate agreement
- ID Check (non-expired, government-issued photo ID such as driver license)
- Signature
- Photograph
- Complete Log-in sheet
- Issuance of testing materials, as applicable
- Testing Room/station assignment
