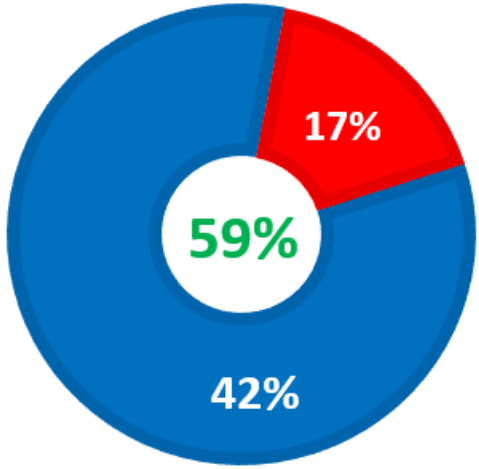
Intended Learning Outcomes

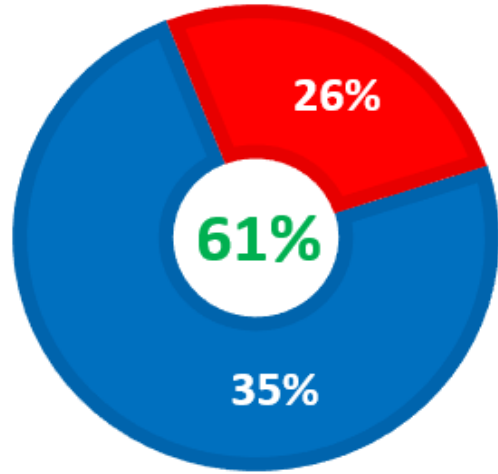
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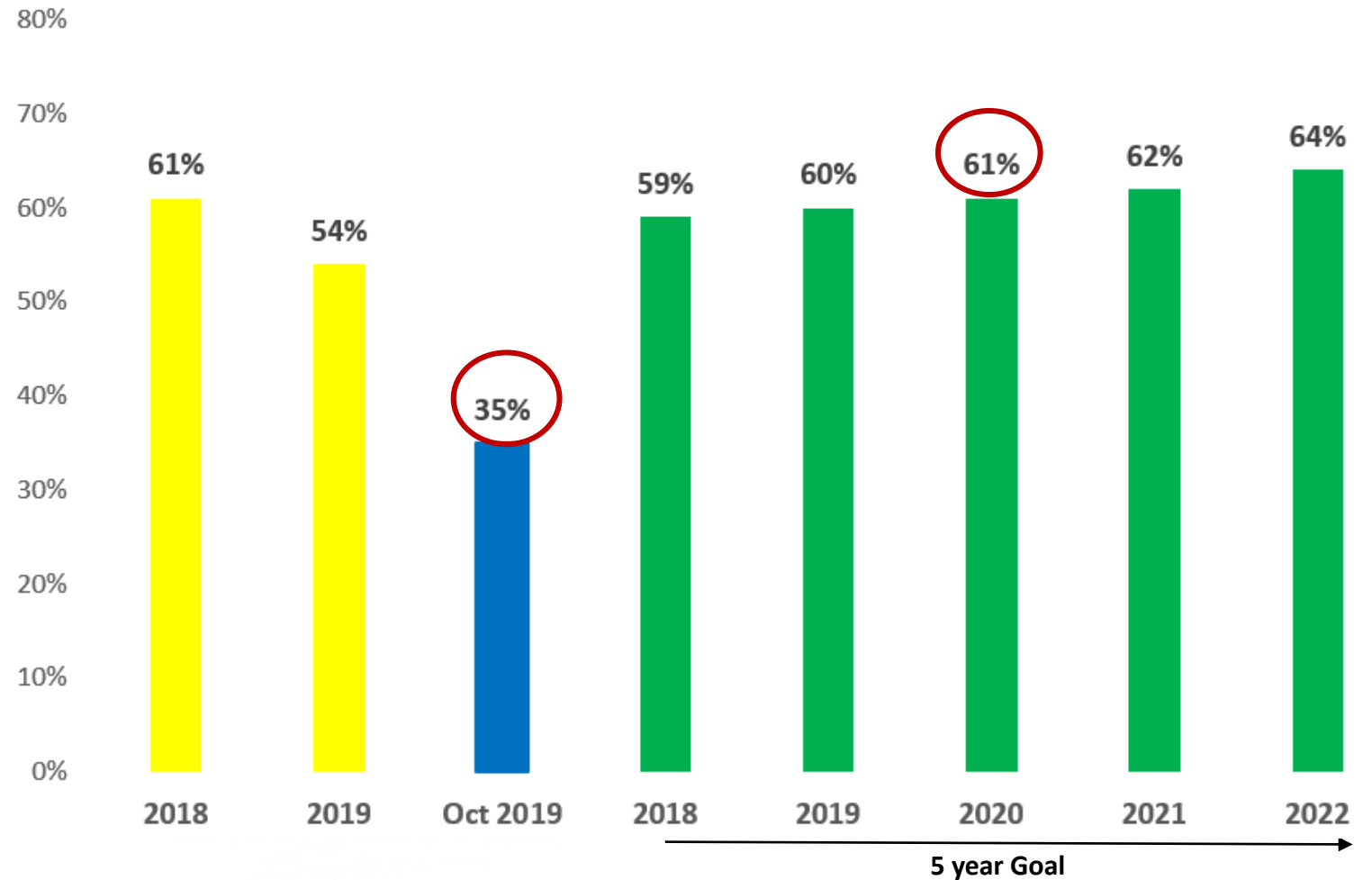
K & 1st Grade Reading



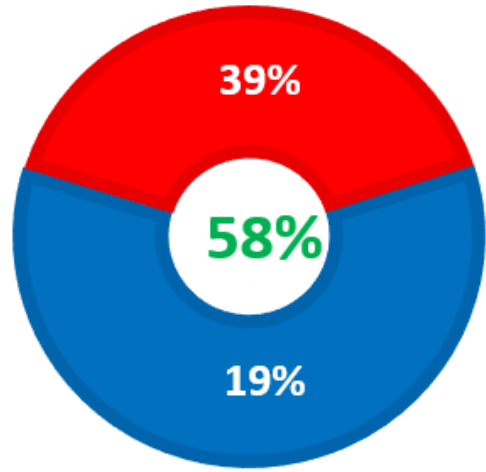
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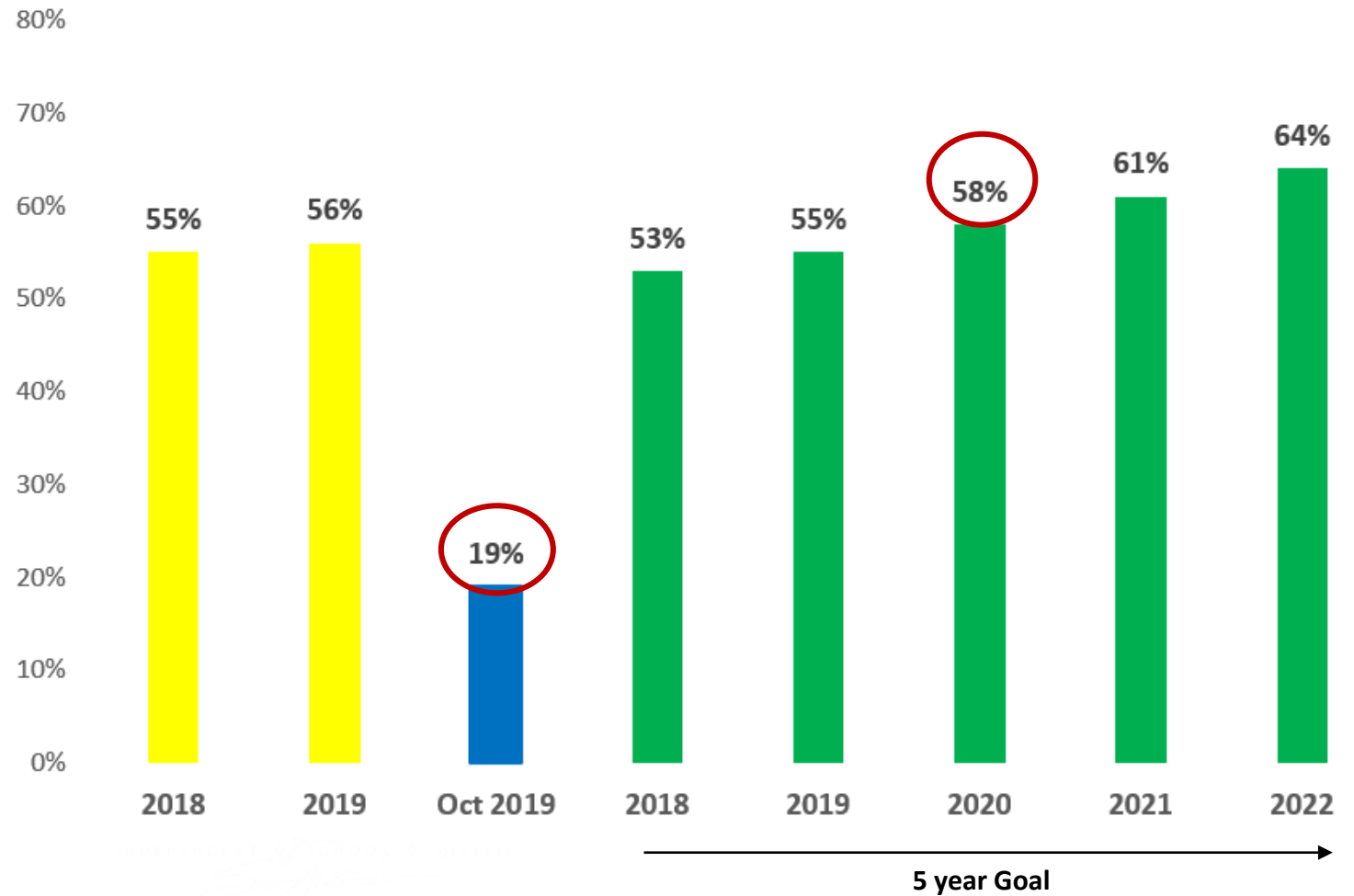
2nd Grade Reading

Refinement
