A weighted average of the accountability indicators will be computed from the number of items meeting targets divided by the number of items evaluated. The weighted average will be scaled to grades A (90-100), B (80-89), C (70-79), D (60-69), and F (0-59) and further used to differentiate all public schools.

(cc) the methodology by which the State differentiates a school as consistently underperforming for any subgroup of students described in section (c)(4)(C)(iii), including the time period used by the State to determine consistent underperformance; and TEA uses the Closing the Gaps domain to identify campuses that have consistently underperforming student groups. Additionally, if any Title Lor non-Title Loampus does not attain a 67 percent four-year federal graduation rate for the all students group, the campus is identified for comprehensive support and improvement.
