Intended Learning Outcomes

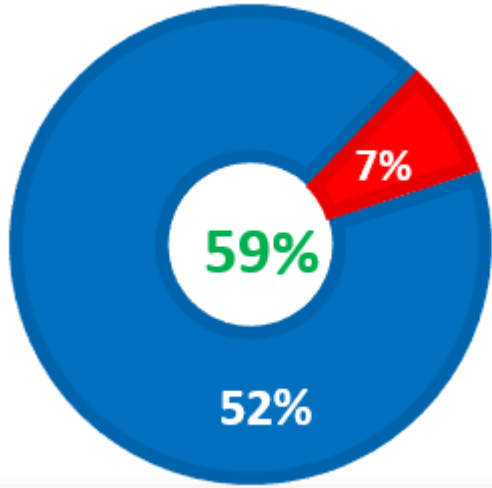

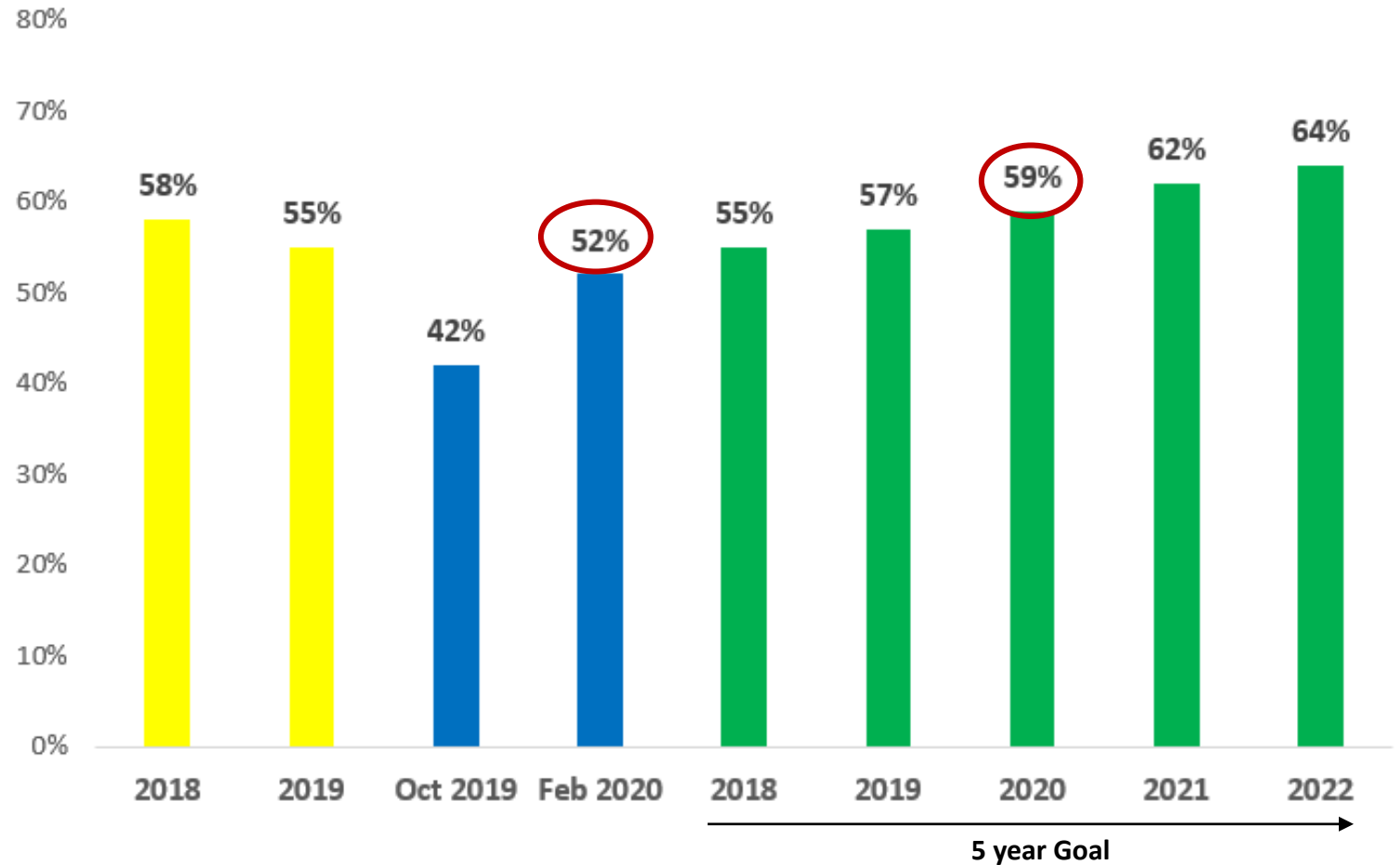

Constraint Progress Measure 2.1: The superintendent shall not allow student outcome goal oriented professional learning to decrease from 53.1% by the end of school year 2022.

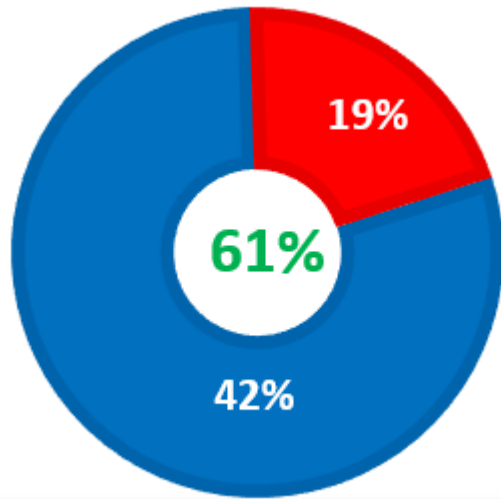

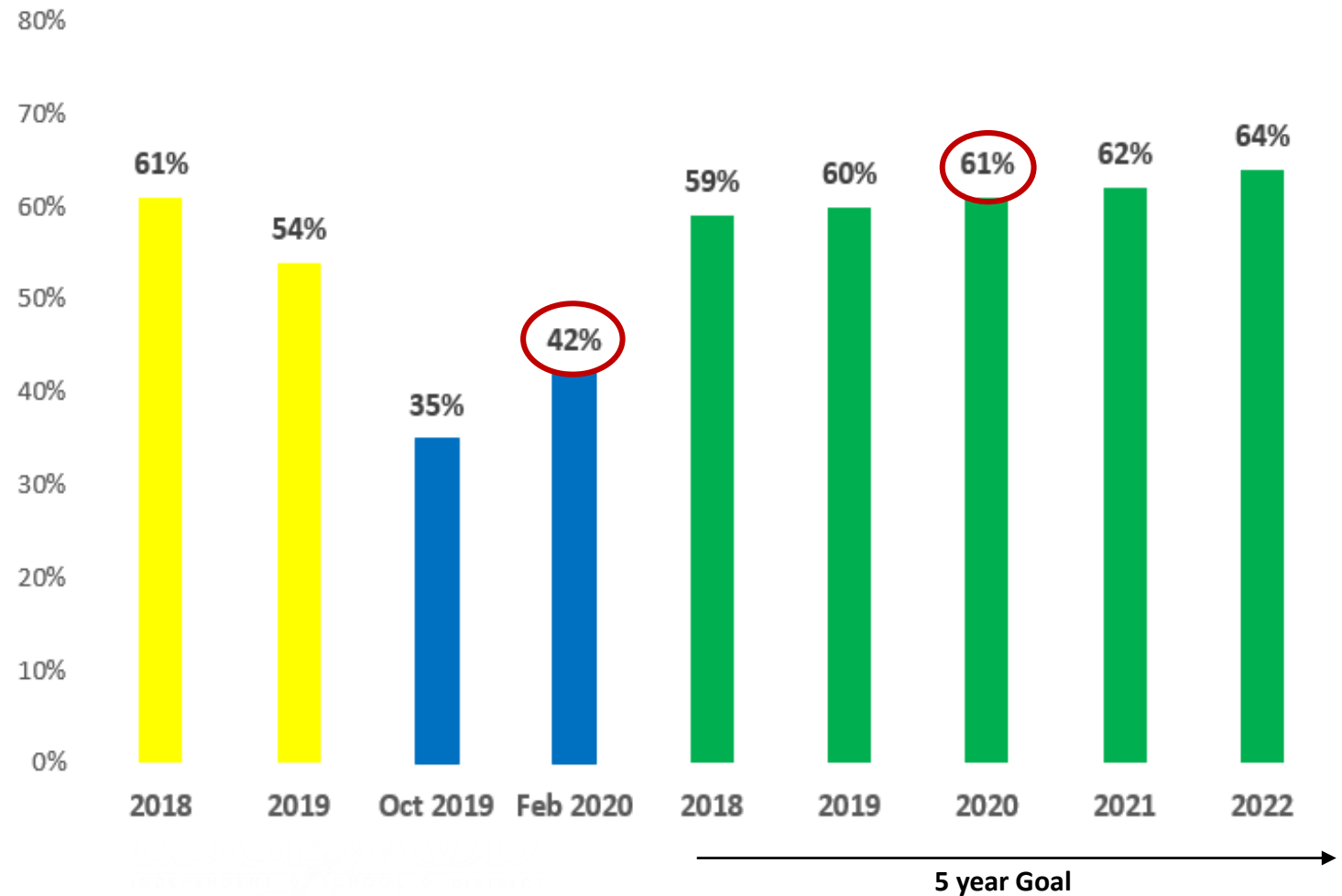
K & 1st Grade Reading



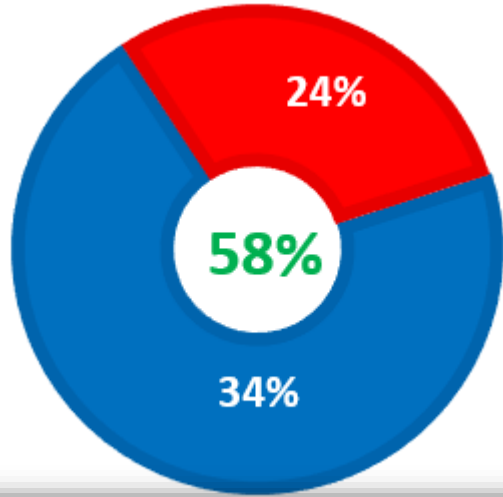
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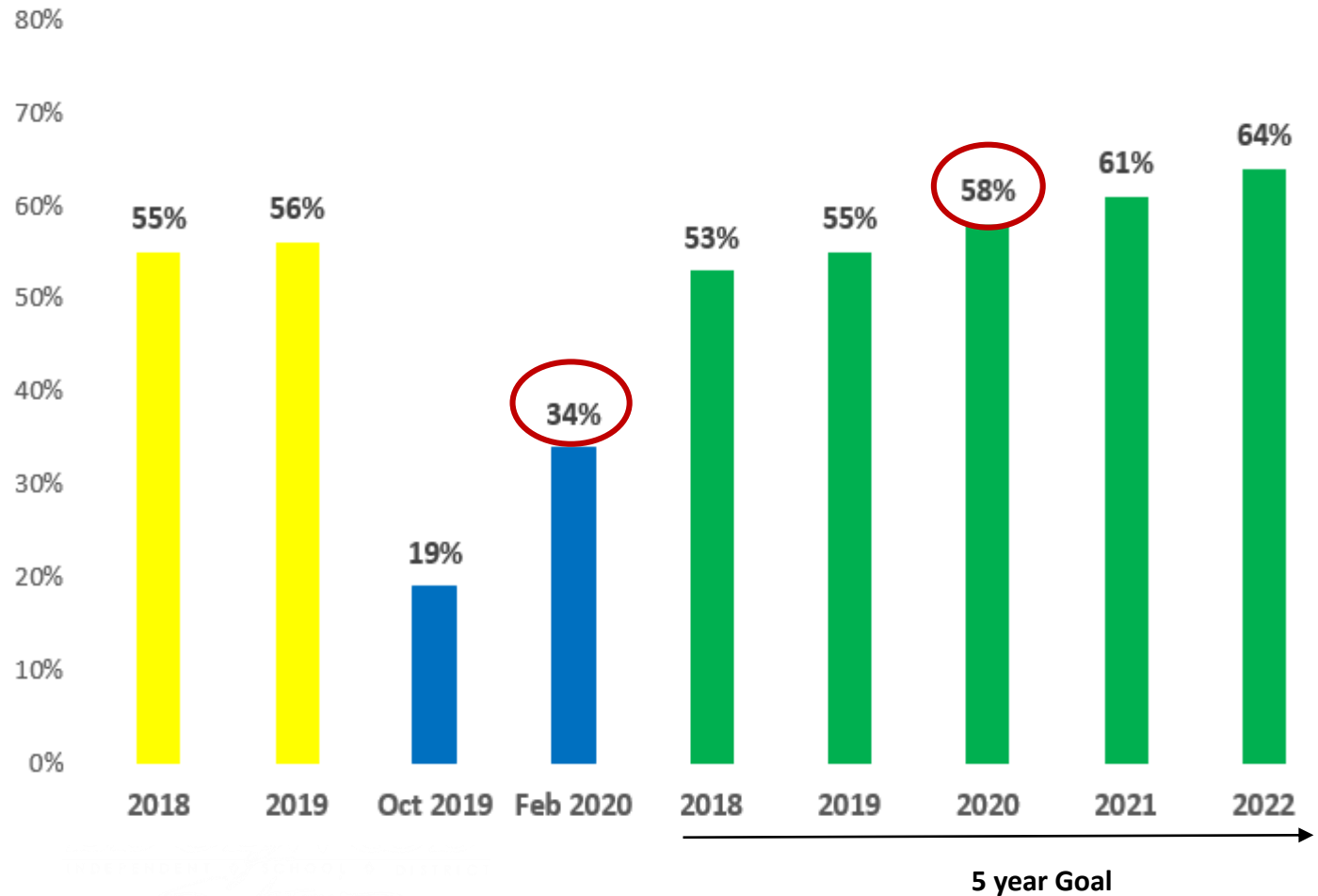
2nd Grade Reading

Reinforcement

- Balanced Literacy time is built in master schedule for 150 minutes for K – 3rd grade
- Instructional materials are highly rigorous to achieve depths of knowledge in vocabulary, fluency, writing, and comprehension
- Leveled book resources available for guided reading/small group instruction



Refinement



- Provide daily Reading Response to Intervention
- Progress monitor student progress
- Ensure all Balance Literacy components are implemented daily in all reading classrooms
- Provide ongoing professional learning

Superintendent Evaluation

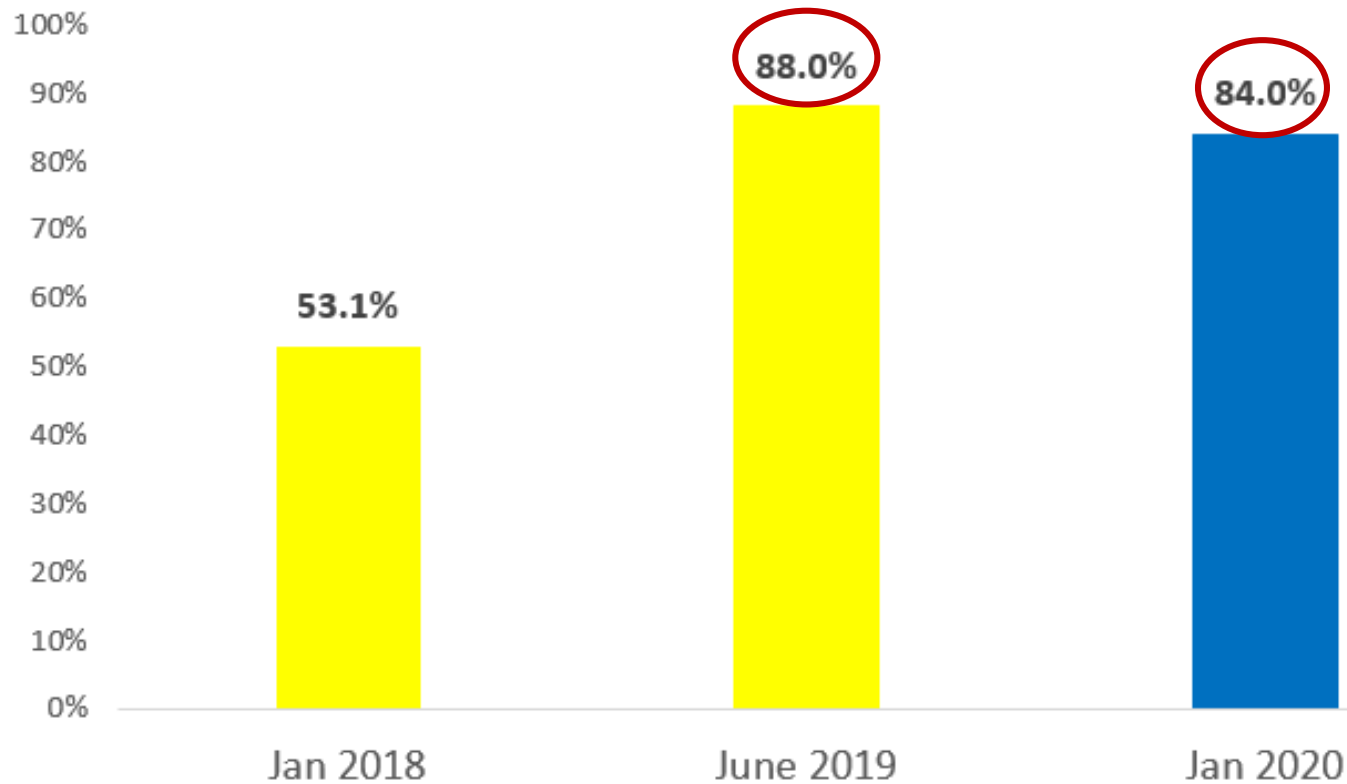
- Instructional literacy coaches to provide training and program monitoring
