Board Workshop: September 8, 2020



Intended Learning Outcomes

- **GPM 3.1**: The percent of students meeting Texas Success Initiative (TSI) criteria in both ELA/reading and mathematics on any of the assessments (Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA), SAT, ACT, College Prep Course) will increase from 16 percent to 25 percent by June 2023.
- **GPM 3.2**: The percent of students meeting the criterion score on an Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) examination in any subject area (criterion score is 3 or more for AP and 4 or more for IB) will increase from eight percent to 18 percent by June 2023.
- **GPM 3.3**: The percent of students completing and earning credit for at least 3 credit hours in English language arts (ELA) or mathematics or at least 9 credit hours in any subject will increase from 13 percent to 25 percent by June 2023.
- **GPM 3.4**: The percent of graduates earning an industry-based certificate under 19 TAC 74.1003 to increase from one percent to ten percent by June 2023.
