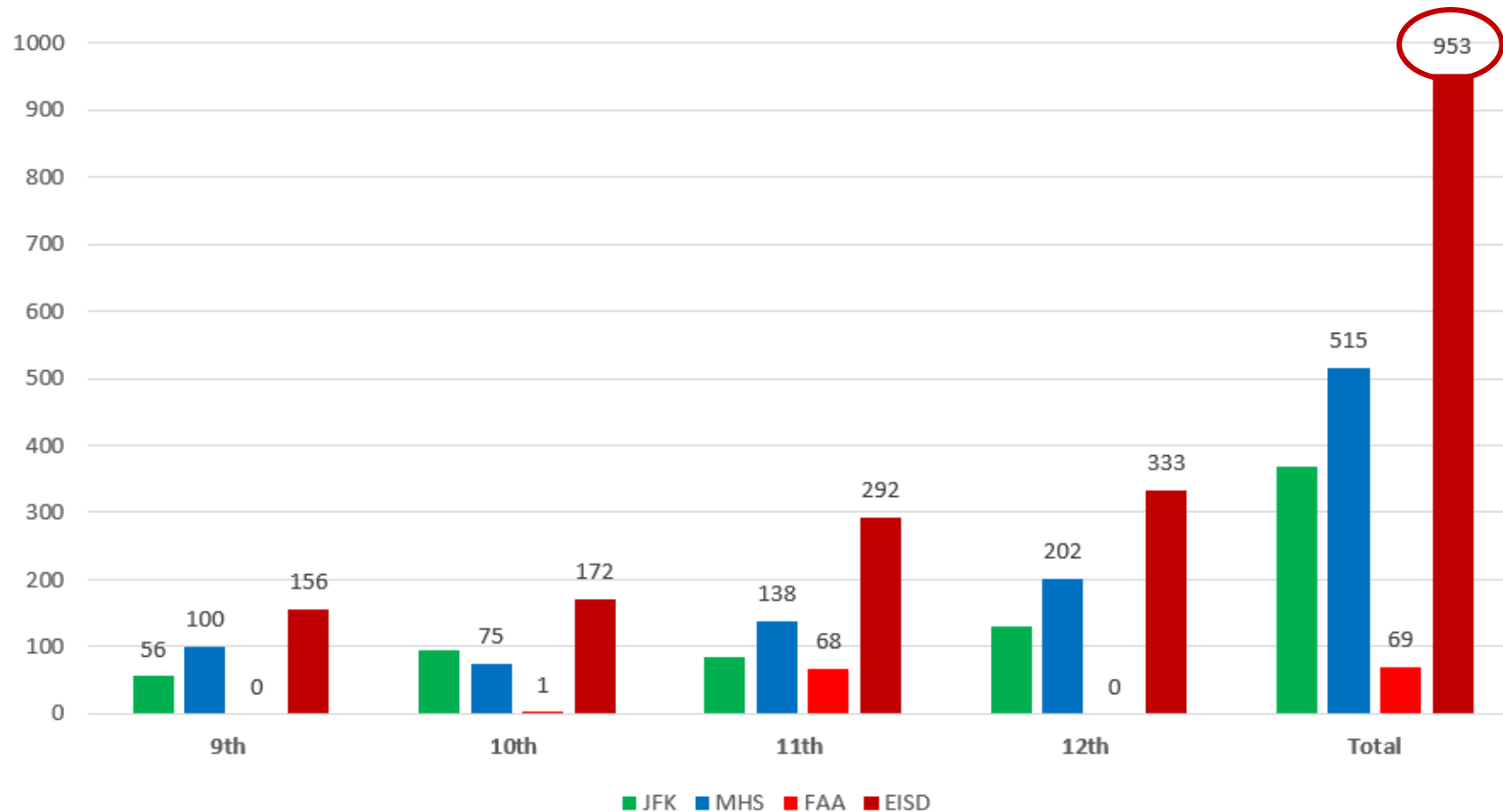

January 2021

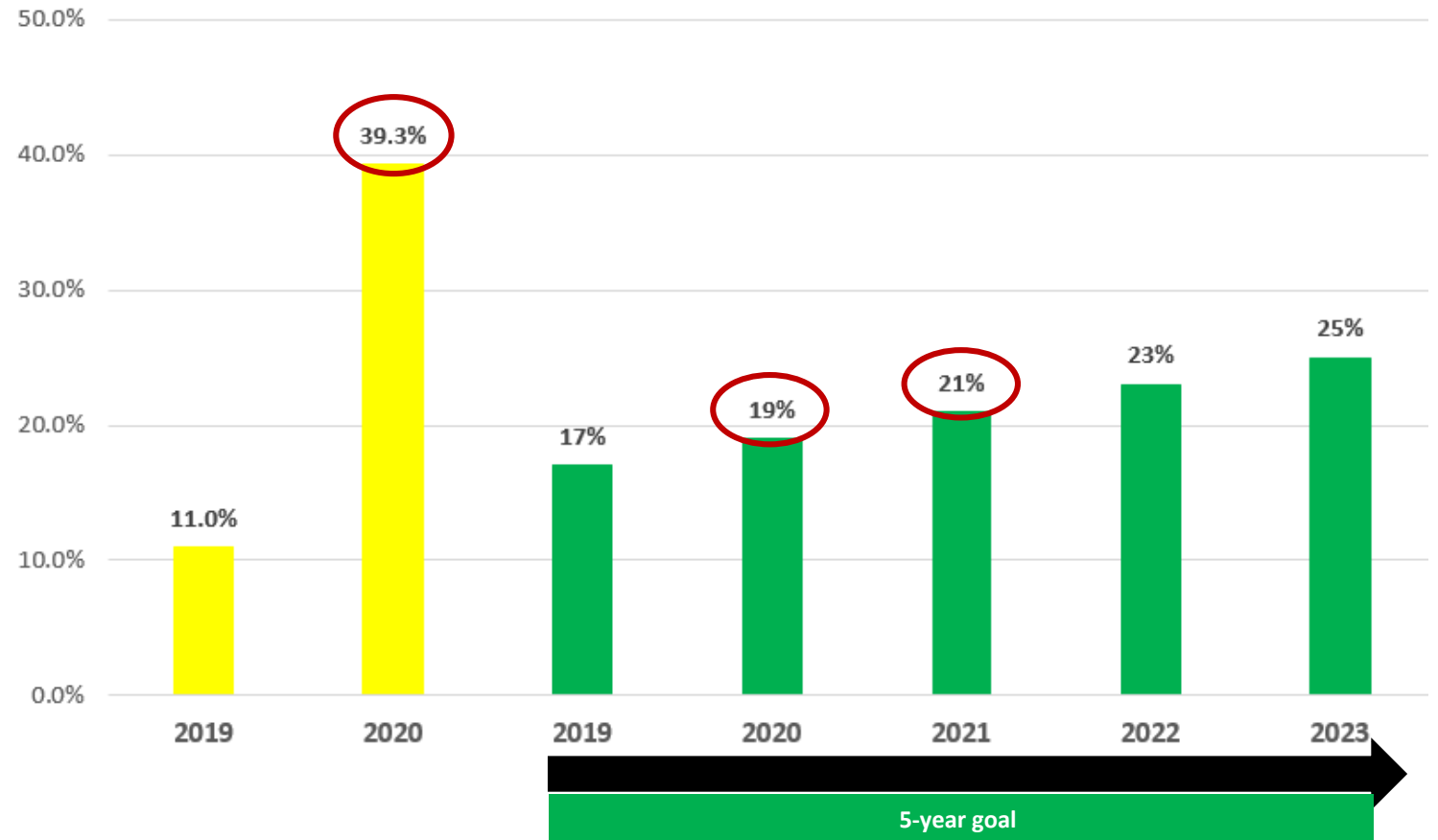

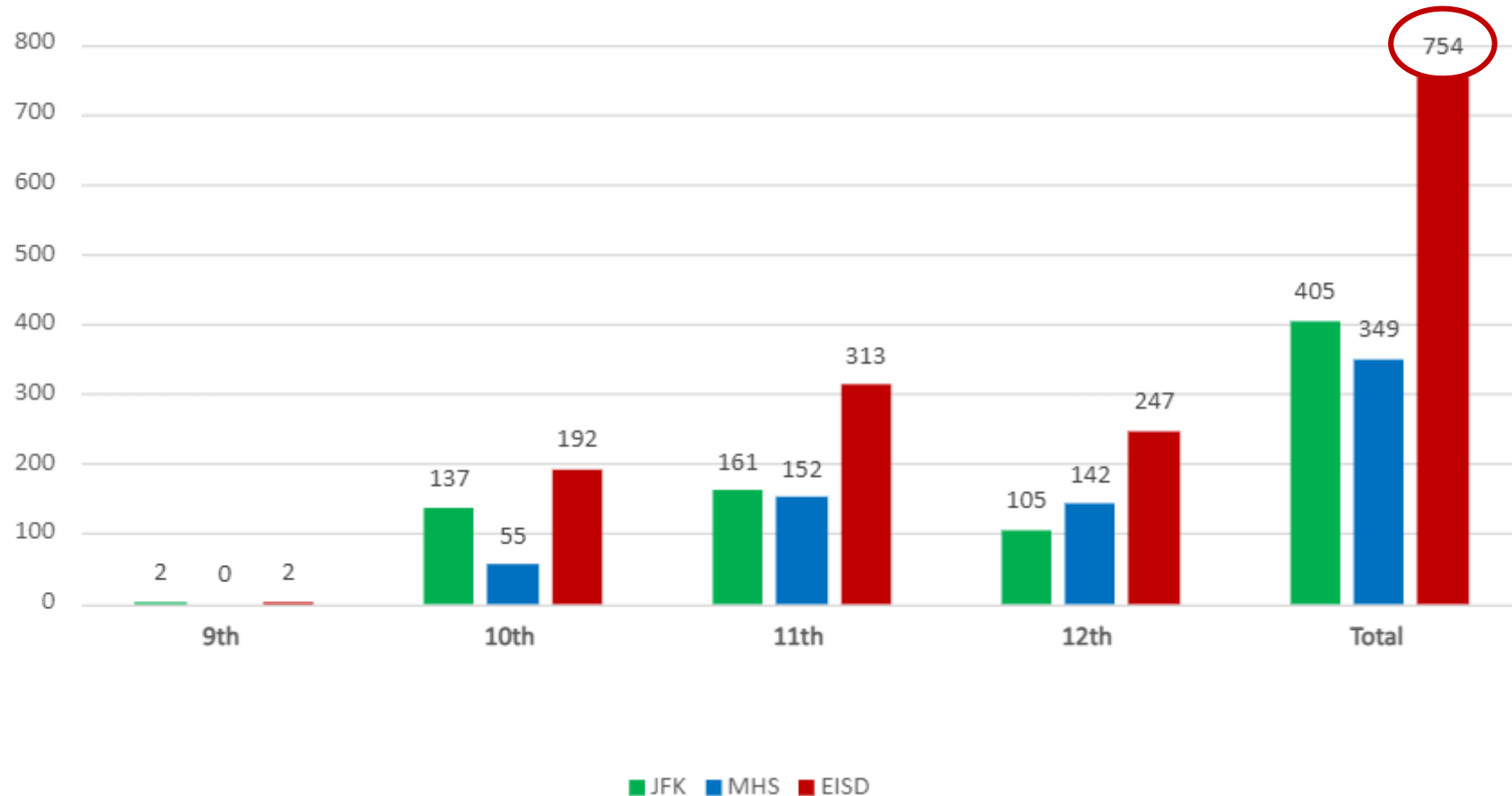

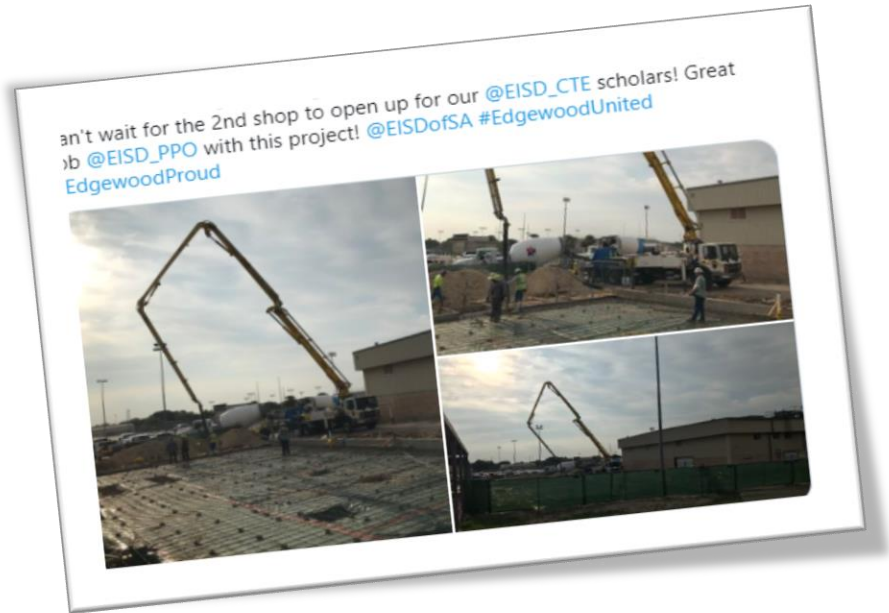
# Dual Credit Enrollment

January 2021



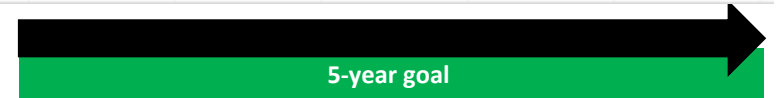
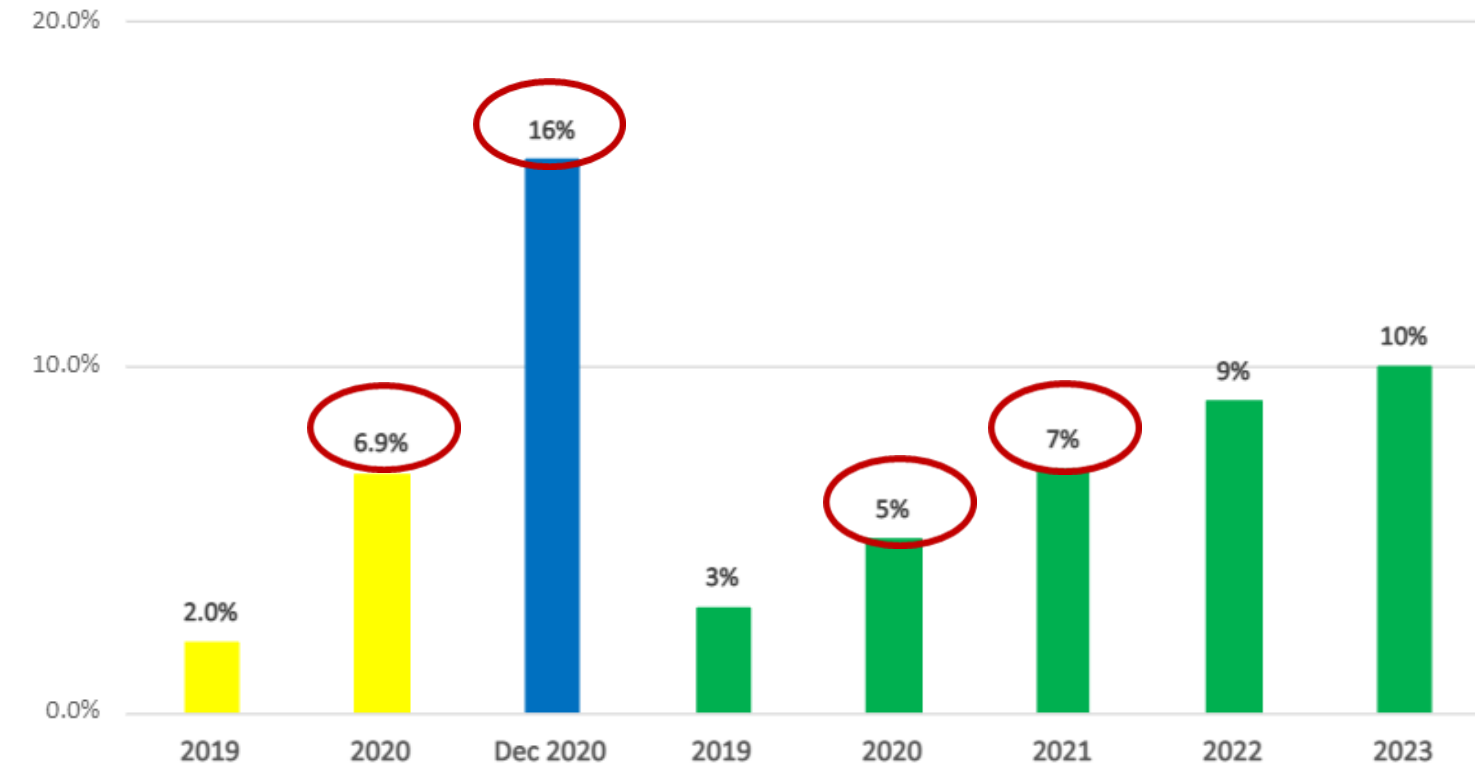

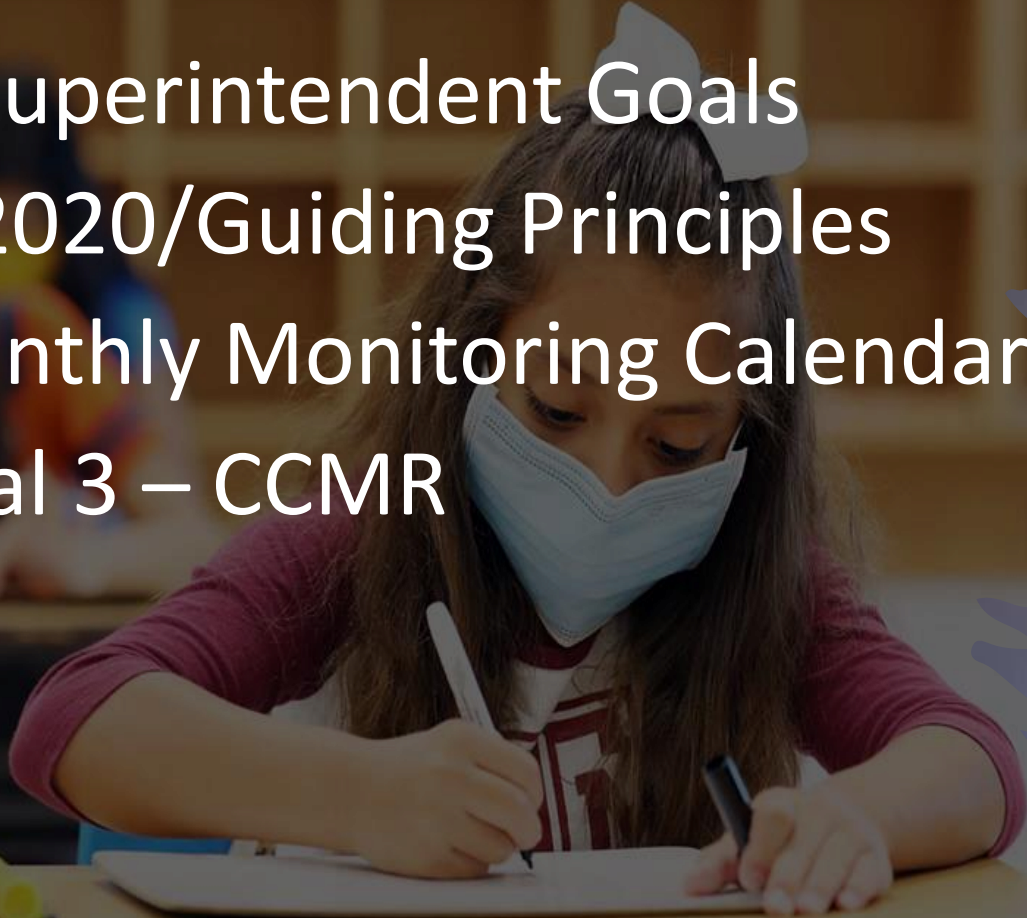
