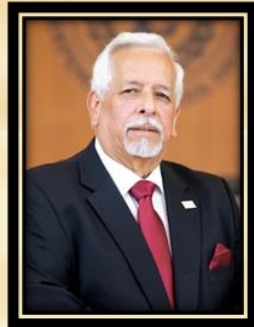

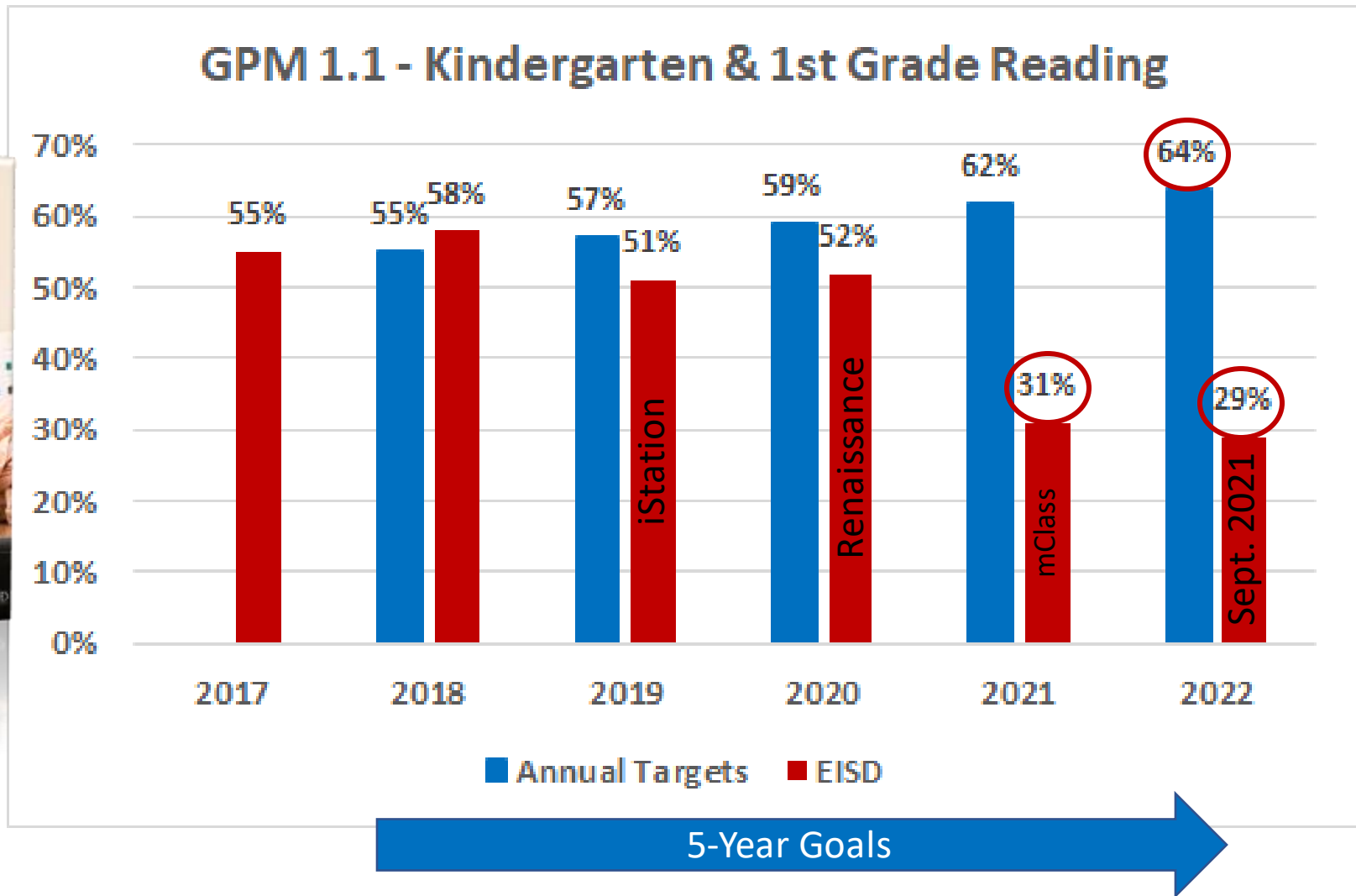
Lone Star Governance Goal 1

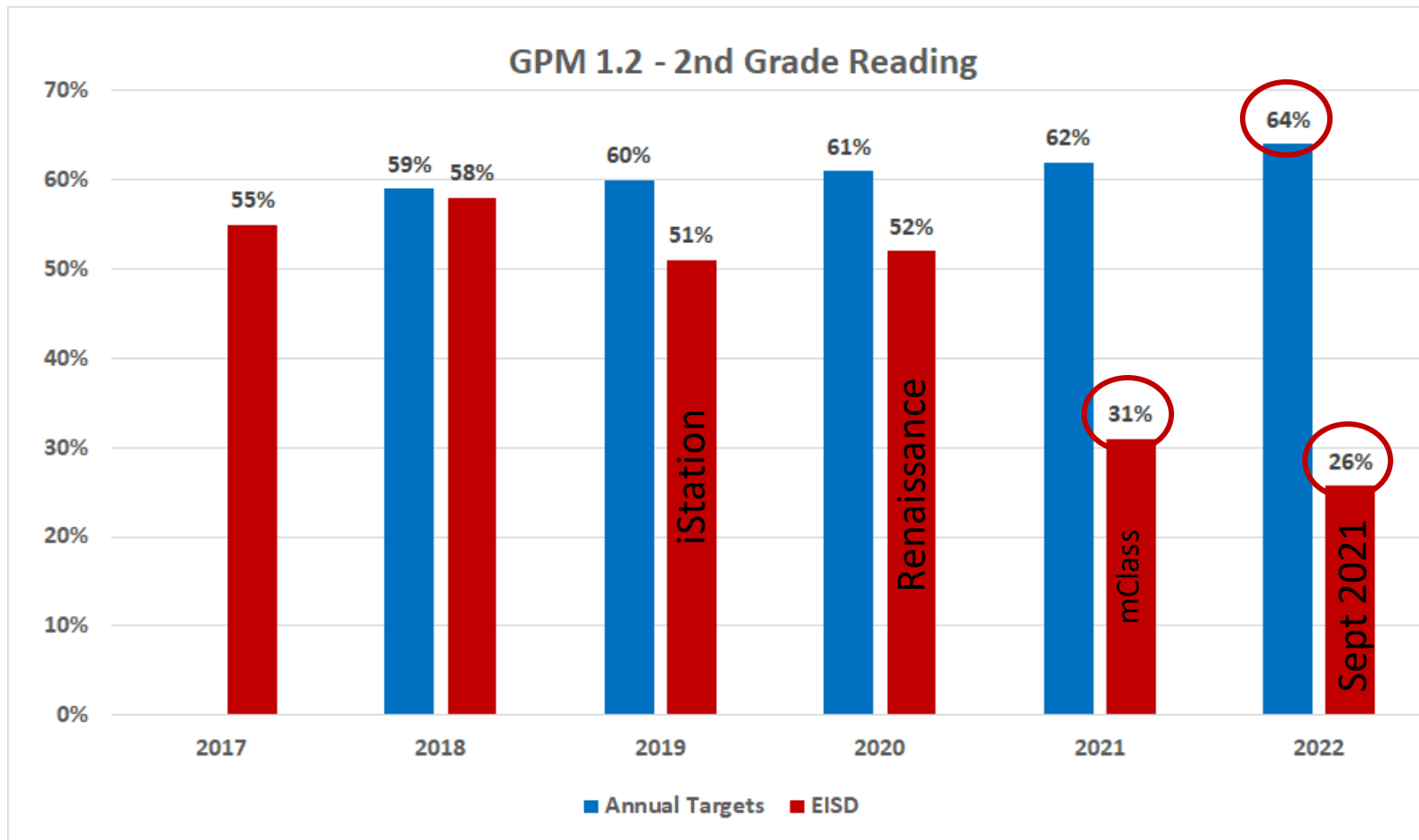

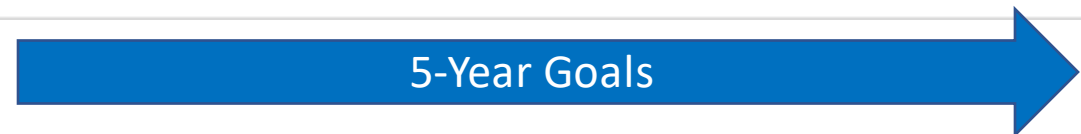
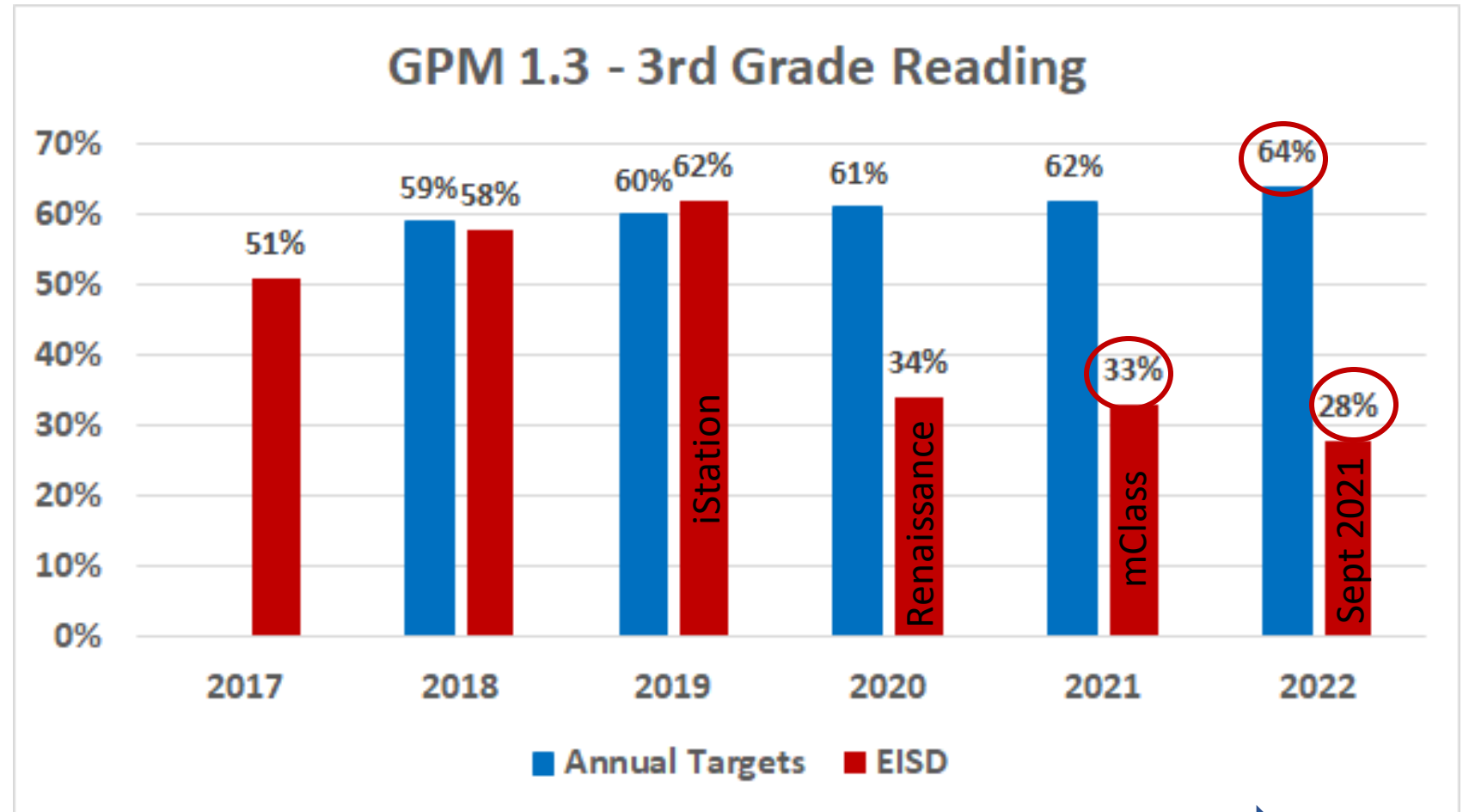
