Governor Abbott, Lt. Governor Patrick, Speaker Phelan Announce \$11.2 Billion In New Funding For Texas Public Schools

Supplemental funds build upon funding previously provided to address pandemic educational challenges

AUSTIN - Governor Greg Abbott, Lieutenant Governor Dan Patrick, and Speaker Dade Phelan today announced the release of \$11.2 billion in new federal funds to help public schools address student learning loss and costs incurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. These one-time funds are intended to support a comprehensive learning recovery effort in Texas over the next three years. Due to federal requirements, two-thirds of the funds are available immediately under grants administered by the Texas Education

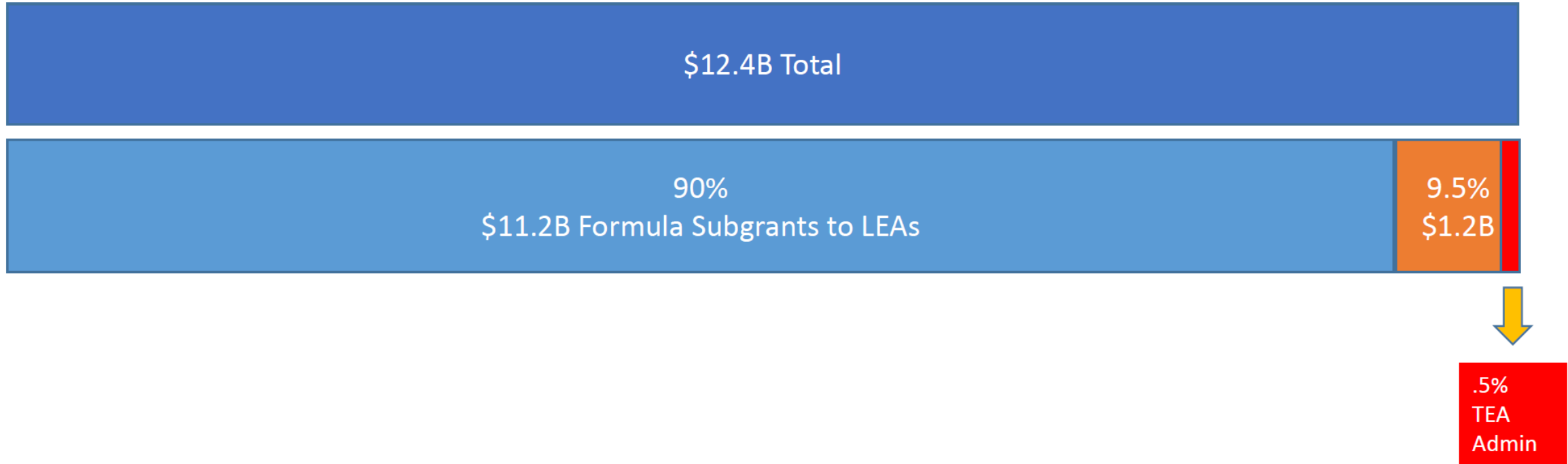


Federal Funding Overview

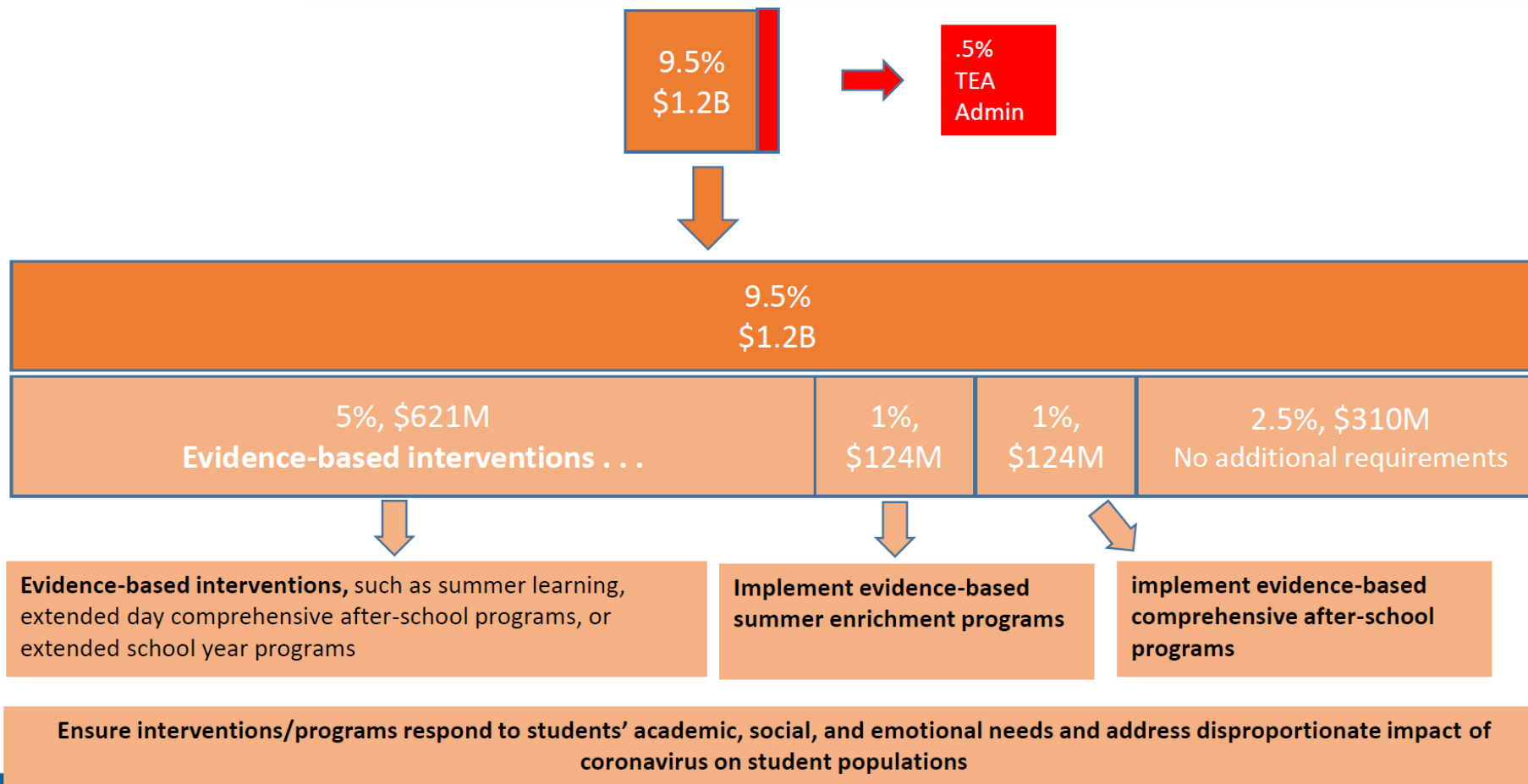


ESSER 3 Funding Overview and Requirements
