- There are countless others that have continued to work hard for our students and staff, despite the many personal challenges that this weather has caused.





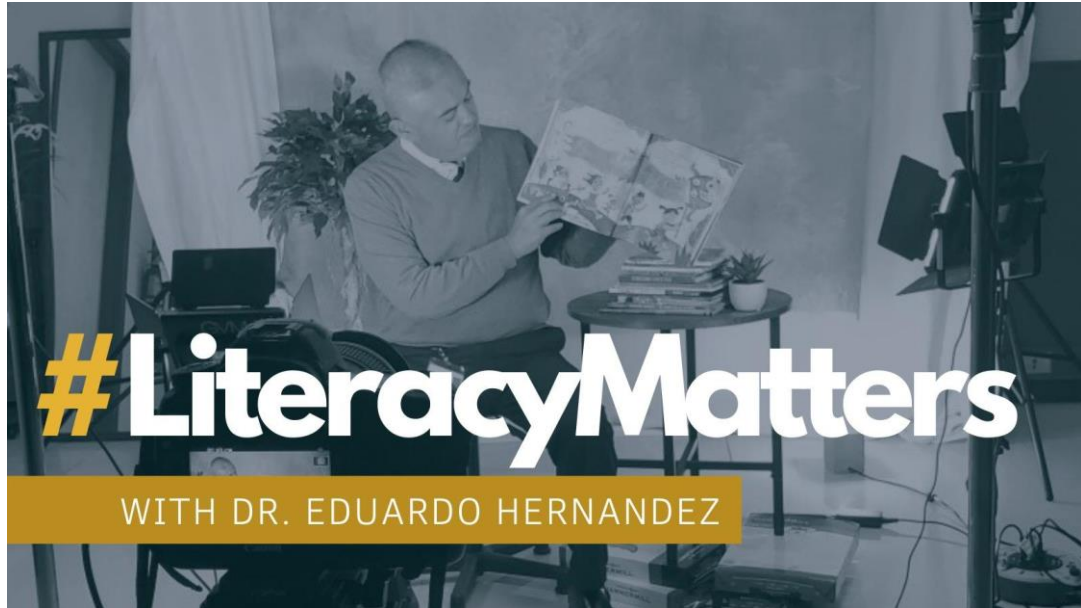
The National Weather Services issued a hazardous weather outlook affecting Bexar County based on the possibility of a hard freeze starting on February 12, 2021.

- Submit necessary waivers to TEA.

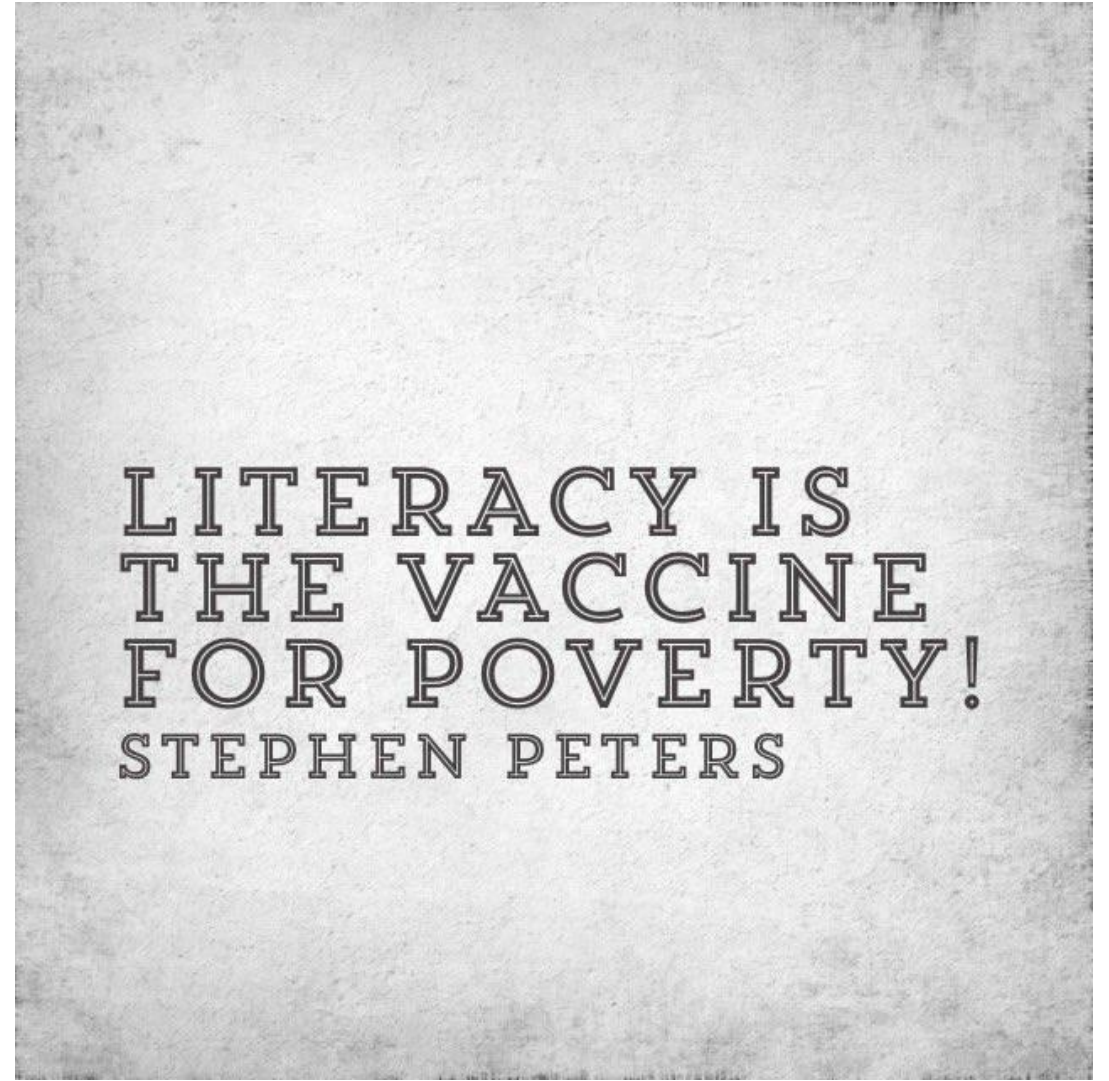
The District has always been and will remain committed to providing the best possible educational opportunities for its students while at the same time keeping all District staff safe and being good stewards of its resources.

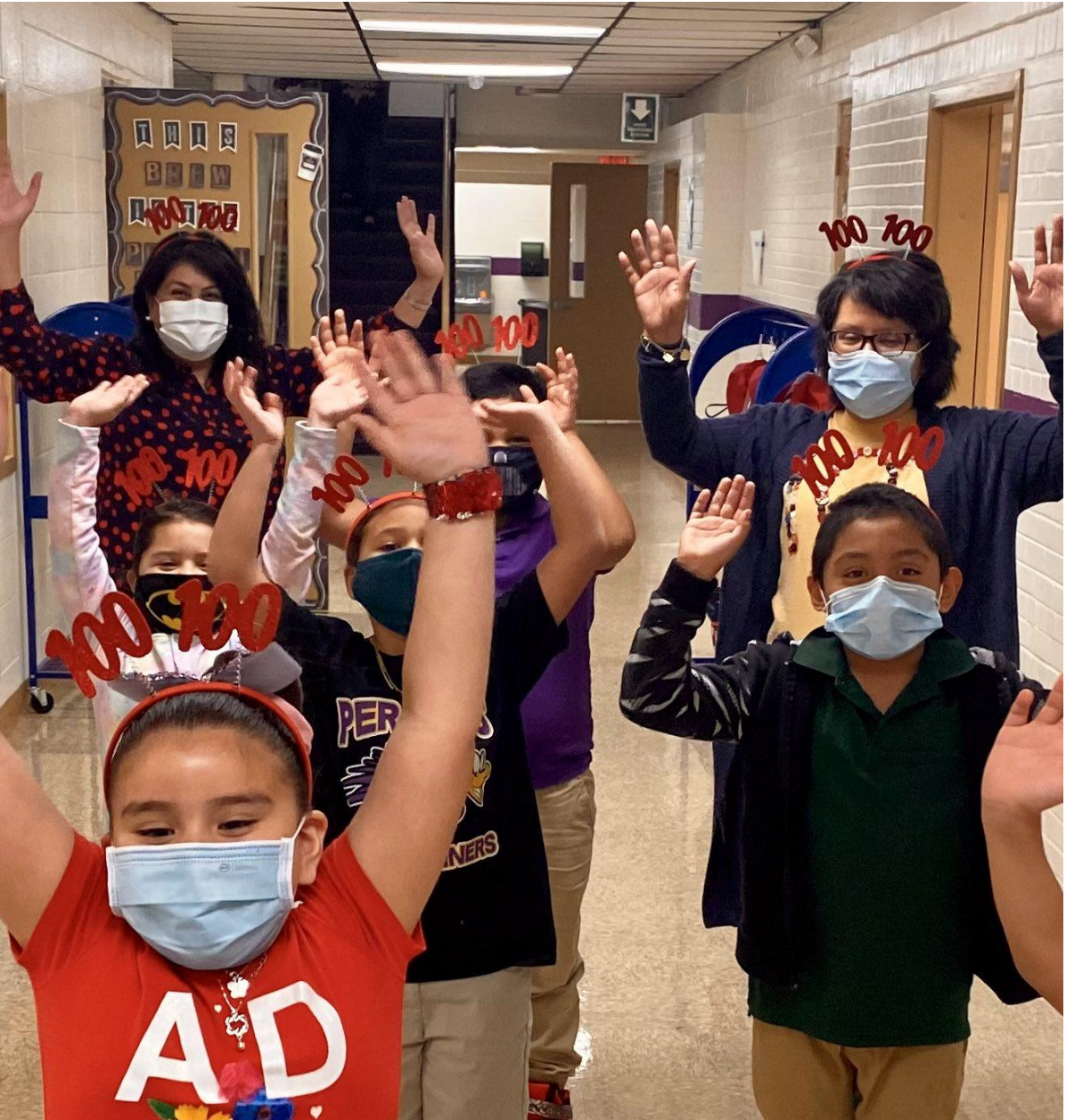
