
Parents, what do you hope is the outcome for your children?

Today's Charge

- Place idea in one of four categories on the map



Next Steps

- 1. All recommendations will be reviewed by the facilities and finance committee to determine:
 - Feasibility/cost
 - Timeline
 - General Impact to the District
 - Fairness to ensure every student benefits and there is inherent value in the changes being recommended.
- Facilities and Finance will review, seek community feedback and ultimately develop final recommendations to the board of trustees
- Facilities and Finance will follow up with the task force to share final recommendations before taking them to the board workshop in November.
