



- Fiscal School Year: August-June







HOUSE BILL 114

Students CAUGHT WITH or
DISTRIBUTING vapes on or
within 300 FEET of school property...

shall be **REMOVED** from class and **SENT** to a **disciplinary alternative education** program (**DAEP**).

NEW LAW – HBII4- NO VAPING
