Las Palmas

1. What are the grades? Co-ed?
 - a. Kinder – 2nd grade will be all girls
 - b. 3rd - 5th will be girls and boys
2. My daughter was accepted but she is going into 3rd grade so will she be in a coed classroom?
 - a. 3rd grade will be girls and boys. Our program for the all-girls for 2020-2021 will be Kinder – 2nd grade.
3. Is Las Palmas going to have Life Skills?
 - a. Yes, our Life Skills Classes will follow the School Model of K – 2nd all-girls and 3rd - 5th will be girls and boys.
4. What about the boys that were in the life skills class at Las Palmas? Where will they go?
 - a. Our Life Skills Classes will follow the School Model of K – 2nd all-girls and 3rd - 5th will be girls and boys.
5. Will there be band available at the girls school?
 - a. Our goal is to support our girls in extracurricular programs. We will continue to work with our students, parents, staff, and community members in decision making as we build out a strong school design each year.
6. Are boys going to be enrolled from 3rd - 5th? This is in the first year of the program.
 - a. 3rd - 5th will be girls and boys.

 - a. Yes, girls in K-5 will be able to attend this 2020-2021 school year.

 - a. Grades 6-8
 - b. Yes, both boys and girls

 - a. American Sign Language is a course offering
3. My daughter will be going to 6th grade do I need to enroll her at gus even if her paperwork was already sent there?

- a. If her paperwork is already there she will not need to enroll again. Please call the school to confirm her registration.
- 4. Several students can have learning disabilities with being a visual learner compared to an on-line learner, what accommodations will be provided for them?
 - a. Our re-entry plan includes face-to-face instruction along with virtual course work
- 5. Is Gus Garcia have Life Skills if even thou it will be a University?
 - a. Yes, Life Skills will continue to be offered at Gus Garcia University School next year.
- 6. If students are enrolled at Guys will they be enrolled in the University or do we need to enroll them for the University?
 - a. Students enrolled at Gus Garcia University School will not need to enroll separately at Texas A&M University San Antonio.
- 7. What Athletics Programs at Gus Garcia?
 - a. Gus Garcia will offer the full compliment of boys and girls athletics programming
- 8. When does school start for Gus?
 - a. Right now, we anticipate the school day to begin at 8:00am, with breakfast at 7:30am. Additional details will be shared as soon as possible.
