

Veterans Stadium Rules 2020 – 2021

- 1. Facial coverings are required, except while eating or drinking
- 2. Please follow social distancing guidelines
- 3. Fans are asked to please sit in the areas marked in **YELLOW**
- 4. Fans are asked to please NOT sit on bleachers marked in **RED**
- 5. Pods larger than four (4) fans will not be allowed
- 6. Paper tickets or face to face ticket purchases will not be available; everyone entering the stadium must have an online ticket, including senior citizens and children 2 and under (\$ 0)
- 7. Fans will enter through the ticket booth gates and will leave the stadium through the exit gates
- 8. A temperature check will be done for all fans, workers, officials, etc. before entering the stadium
- 9. Fans, please have your belongings with you before entering the stadium; re-entry will not be allowed
- 10. Outside food or drinks are prohibited
- 11. Visiting bands and dance teams will not be allowed
- 12. Capacity limits: Home Side 875/Visitors' Side 875; break down 5 admin tickets no charge, 20 senior citizen tickets no charge; children 2 years old and younger no charge
- 13. Tickets online ticketing at GoFan.com; parameters Sunday 6 p.m. noon on Tuesday of game week, tickets will be available to players' parents (2 tickets per purchase); general public tickets will become available on Tuesday of game week at 12:01 p.m. and will sell until sold out; if tickets are still available at game time, ticket purchasing kiosks will be available at the stadium's entrance; on-line ticket purchasing instructions will be forwarded to the opponents' athletic office and the opposing head coach
- 14. Buses and equipment: Team buses and equipment will enter through Kennedy Park (located on the south side of the stadium); team buses and team equipment vehicles can drive up to the field house and unload; once unloaded buses will park in the Kennedy Park parking lot; lot is patrolled by E.I.S.D. police throughout the event.
- 15. Locker rooms: will be made available to teams 2 hours before kick-off and at halftime; coaches are asked to limit and stagger entry of players into the locker room at any one time; at the end of halftime, coaches must ask players to clear the locker room of all personal belongings as locker rooms will be locked and not available after the game
- 16. Water: Water in sanitized containers will be provided to both teams for use if desired; injury ice will also be provided for both teams on their sidelines
- 17. Hand Sanitizer: two hand sanitizing stations will be available on both sidelines
- 18. Field and sideline: Only water is allowed on the sidelines; colored drinks, seeds, gum, etc. are prohibited; 4 benches are provided for each team; two tables and trash cans are provided for each sideline; the area directly behind the team benches will be roped off from the 20 yard line to the opposite 20 yard line
- 19. Press Box: Only 2 visiting team coaches will be allowed in the press box (located on the second floor, first room on the north side of the press box); camera and only 1 operator will be allowed in the press box; the film deck is located at the center of the second floor
