Essay: The essay must portray the candidate’s personal experience in reflecting José Antonio Navarro’s life and spirit. The candidate must refer to his or her reflections upon visiting the Casa Navarro State Historic Site and how Navarro’s historical participation influenced his world and how his contributions are relative today. Essays should be no more than two double spaced typed pages with one-inch margins and submitted with completed application or as a separate file in PDF or Microsoft Word format. **Essay should be titled “JAN Essay” and include YOUR FULL NAME.**
