GRADUATION REHEARSAL INFORMATION

- All graduates are required to attend rehearsal.
- All graduates must ride the school bus to Freeman Coliseum.
- Buses will pick up graduates at 1:30 pm at Memorial High School.
- If a student does not attend rehearsal, they will **NOT** be allowed to participate in Graduation.
- A permission slip must be completed and submitted to the Senior Counselor.

GRADUATION CEREMONY INFORMATION

- All graduates are required to ride the school bus to Freeman Coliseum.
- All graduates must be in compliance with EISD student dress code. (Hair color, piercings, etc.)
- Buses will pick up graduates at 12:30 pm at Memorial High School.
- If a student does not ride the school bus, they will **NOT** be allowed to participate in Graduation.
- A permission slip must be completed and submitted to the Senior Counselor.
- Graduates are not required to ride the bus back to campus after Graduation.

INFORMATION FOR GUESTS

- Guests will be able to enter Freeman Coliseum at 1:30 pm.
- There is no limit to the number of guests that are allowed.
- Air horns, loud noisemakers, baby carriers/strollers, glass, balloons or signs are **NOT** allowed.
- EISD No Purse/No Bags policy will be enforced. Only clear bags will be allowed.
- There is no reserved seating.
- Parking is \$10. Advanced parking tickets available at Emma Frey Service Center for \$7, May 28-30 from 8:00 am – 4:30 pm. Cash only. Please have exact change.
